# ANNUAL EDUCATION REPORT FOR ANDERSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

## 1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Resident students attend the school in the attendance area of the Grand Blanc Community School District in which they reside. The Grand Blanc Community School District does have a policy and a process for *School of Choice* requests. Copies of this policy and procedures are available through the Central Administration Office.

## 2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

### 2009-2010 School Year

In the past year, Anderson's School Improvement Plan has continued to meet all requirements for Accreditation through the North Central Association, utilize the NCA Baldrige Quality Process as a model for overall building improvement and continued implementing our Professional Learning Communities. We are proud of the fact that during the 2009-10 school year, 99% of our 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students passed the Math MEAP test.

### 2010-2011 School Year

During the 2010-2011 year 96% of our students passed the Math MEAP and 86% passed the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade reading MEAP. Anderson Elementary staff continues to integrate science, social studies and technology into the math and reading goals. Goals continue to be based the information gathered from the Advance Ed Report, School Data Profile, the student assessment data, the building self assessment and the internal/external audits.

All schools in our district were awarded continued accreditation in 2011 by AdvancED.

## 3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL

- Anderson Elementary offers a Multi-Age classroom where students remain with the same teacher for more than one year, creating a 'family' atmosphere. This concept eliminates transitions and allows children to bond with a significant adult.
- Grand Blanc Community Schools offers a specialized school for interested students in grades 1-5. The program affords opportunities in extending the regular elementary curriculum with additional in-depth educational and enrichment experiences. Two of the key components of the program include: a multi-age classroom organizational pattern; and, an extensive family involvement in the daily education program.

The Grand Blanc District has worked diligently to incorporate the state core curriculum, including standards and benchmarks, in the District’s curriculum offerings. We are aligned with all of the current state Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCE’s). Core curriculum areas necessitating such attention include: Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Health, Physical Education, Foreign Language and Technology. The District’s core curriculum is available to review at the District’s administration building.
